PURPOSE

The Samuel Elliott Perkins IV Memorial Scholarship was created by Mary Perkins in memory of her husband for the purpose of providing scholarships to Marshall County resident students pursuing a degree from Purdue University.

THE AWARD (2017/2018 School Year)

Approximately \$68,000 will be awarded in varying amounts to multiple Marshall County high school graduates and current Purdue students. There will be a number of NON-RENEWABLE scholarships awarded in varying amounts.

ELIGIBILITY

- The applicant must be continuing their enrollment at Purdue University as a full time student for the fall of 2017 in pursuit of a Purdue Diploma.
- The applicant must be a permanent resident of Marshall County and a graduate of a Marshall County high school.
- The applicant must be a sophomore, junior or senior status. No applicant may win more than 4 Perkins awards.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- The applicant must have a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA.
- The applicant must demonstrate participation in school and extracurricular activities.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The applicant must complete or provide the following information to be considered for the Samuel Elliott Perkins IV Memorial Scholarship:

- Transcript with grades through the most recent semester completed.
